### **CITY OF BONN**

The Bonn region is regarded as the gateway to the romantic Rhine with the Siebengebirge mountains and Drachenfels shrouded in legend. The federal city Bonn is, like Koblenz, situated at the border of the river Rhine. It is in the federal state North-Rhine Westphalia. With about 325 thousand inhabitants it is one of the 20 largest cities in Germany.

Bonn is also known as the native town of Ludwig van Beethoven, a famous musician and composer. The Beethoven House, the house where the musician was born, is now a museum and tells stories from the life of the world-famous composer. After the second world war, Bonn became the provisional capital of Germany. This temporary arrangement lasted 41 years. Many Baroque buildings date back to the time when Bonn was the place of residence of the Electors.
